## **GENDER STUDIES - MINOR**



Students minoring in Gender Studies take 6 credits in core courses and 12 elective credits for a total of 18 credits. With approval, students double count 9 credits taken for general education or the major. To graduate with a minor in gender studies, a student must achieve a grade of C (2.0) or better in all courses required for the minor and 6 credits must be at the 300-level or above.
